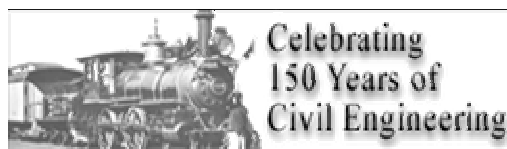

The 2001-2002 Installation Banquet for the Acadiana ASCE Branch was held on September 12, 2001 at the Petroleum Club. New officers that were installed included:

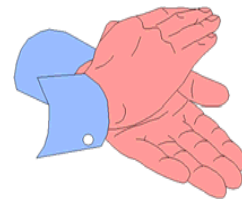

National News

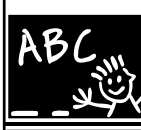
